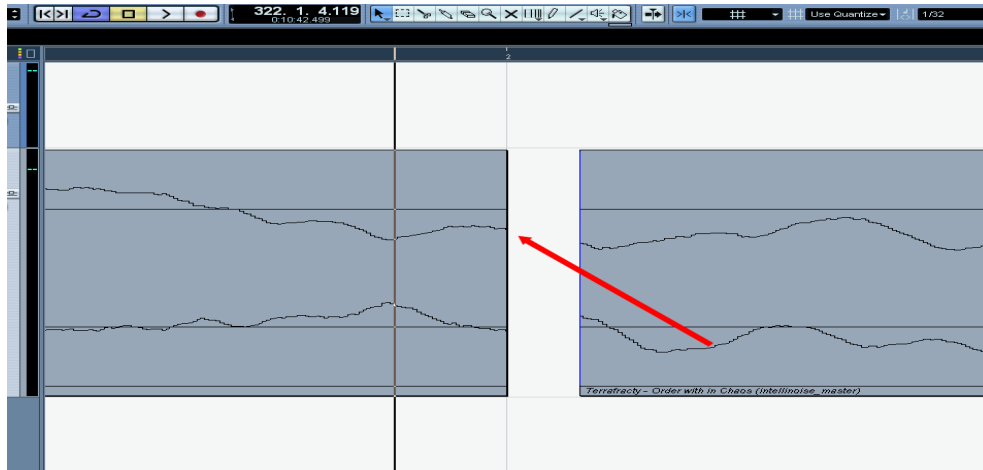


Please remove clicks in your music

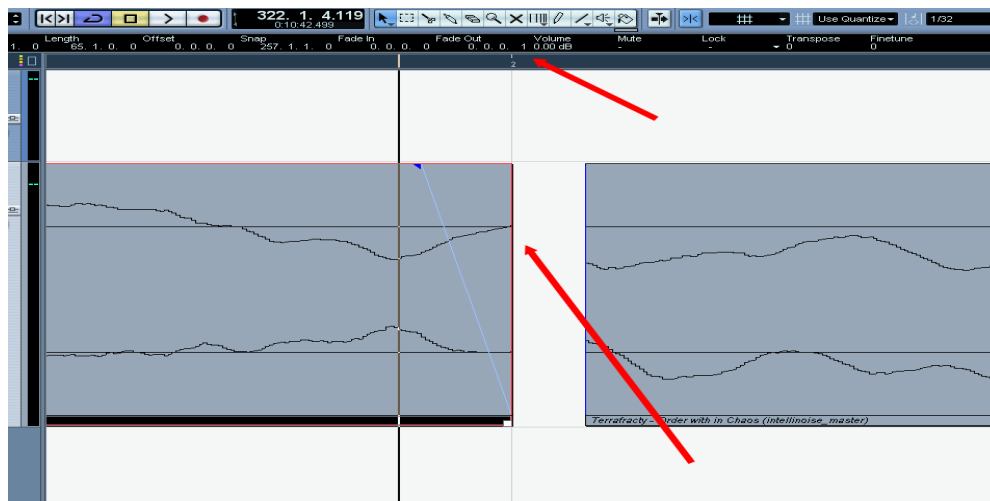
Audio Clicks has been something disturbing me very much, and there is plenty of them in everyone's music. It mostly comes from working with cutting audio and not fading the signal in or out.

To make your work cleaner, think about removing the clicks directly after cutting your audio samples.

On this picture, you can see that when you cut an audio part, the signal won't stop at a 0db point. Imagine your speaker having to move from a certain value back to 0 in no time, that makes a clic !



To avoid this, simply add some fade out (or fade in for the beginning of the part). In Cubase, you can select a bunch of audio parts and fade all of them at once. You can make it manually using the small triangle at the edges of the parts, or using the "event info line."



When it is about high frequencies, very short fades (1 or 2ms) are good enough. For long wave frequencies (bass), you might need more to remove the audible clic. (up to 10ms).
